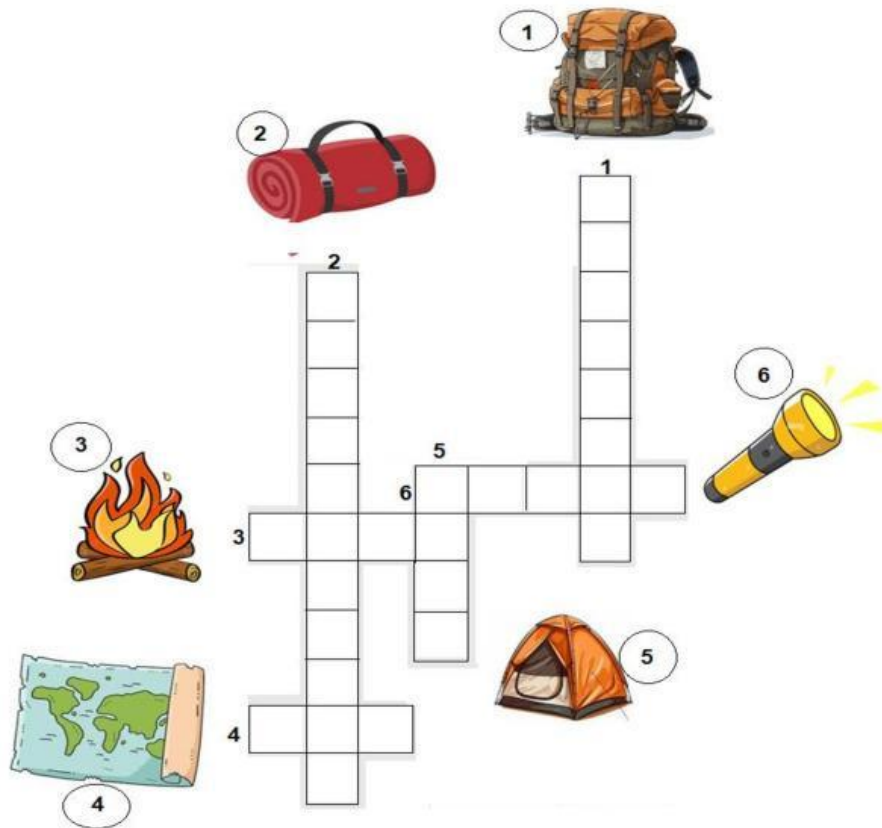


LET'S READ "A CAMPING TRIP"
