### READING

#### Top tips for memorizing

Are you good at memorizing lists of facts for an important exam? If the answer is no, don't worry. There are several different techniques you can use. Here are our top three.

- 6 Use images. Studies show that we can understand pictures 60,000 times faster than words. So, take a fact that you want to learn and change it into a picture. Try to make the picture funny or strange because this will help you to remember it.
- 7 Use mnemonics. A mnemonic is a short phrase or pattern that explains an important rule or fact. For example, to remember how to spell *because*, you can learn: **big** elephants **can** always understand **small** elephants.
- 8 Use groups. With this technique, put small pieces of information together into larger groups. In fact, the majority of people already do this for phone numbers. Research shows that it's very difficult to remember a sequence of nine separate numbers: 5-4-8-9-3-2-7-5-6, for example. But if you group them, for example: 548 932 756 – it becomes much easier.

With all of these techniques, practice is essential. Choose one of the tips and practise it every day. Then test yourself to see how well it works. And don't forget that remembering facts is only one part of studying for any exam. Make sure you also really understand the subject.
