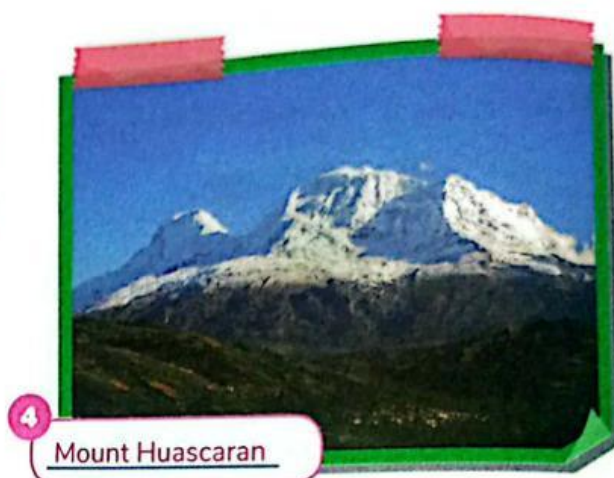
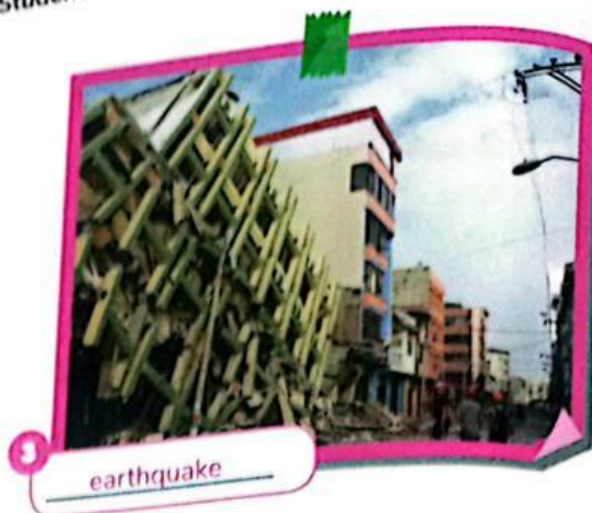

HOW DID THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON START?

Sunday, September 2, 1666

The fire started (start) early in the morning in Pudding Lane, in the house of baker Thomas Faynor. The family escaped (escape) through an upstairs window.

The fire continued (continue) to spread. People were in a panic.

King Charles II ordered (order) the Mayor, Sir William Bolton, to pull down any houses necessary to stop the fire spreading.

Monday, September 3, 1666

The fire continued (continue) to spread. The river Thames was full of boats packed (pack) with people and their belongings.

Boat owners charged (charge) a lot, so most people carried (carry) whatever they could.

Tuesday, September 4, 1666

The fire didn't stop. It destroyed (destroy) St Paul's Cathedral

Thursday, September 6, 1666

There was no more fire. The fire damaged (damage) 87 churches including St Paul's Cathedral, and 13,200 houses. Amazingly, only 6 people died (die).
