Let's talk about the clothes you wear and buy

Dev: How often \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ a skirt Tess? (wear)

Tess: I \_\_\_\_\_ a skirt twice a week. (wear)

Dev: \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ a skirt now? (wear)

Tess: No, I \_\_\_\_\_. I \_\_\_\_\_ a dress today.  
(wear)

Dev: \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ trainers today? (wear)

Tess: No, I \_\_\_\_\_. It \_\_\_\_\_ very warm outside  
today, so I \_\_\_\_\_ sandals. (wear)

Dev: \_\_\_\_\_ you usually \_\_\_\_\_ a t-shirt to school?  
(wear)

Tess: Yes, I \_\_\_\_\_

Dev: How often do you \_\_\_\_\_ a new t-shirt at the  
store? (buy)

Tess: My mum \_\_\_\_\_ me a new t-shirt at the  
store four times a year. (buy)
