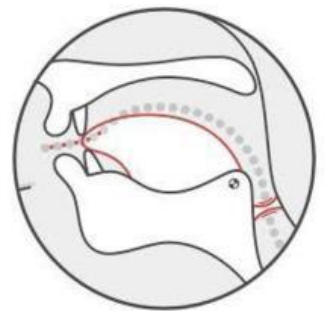
Consonant sound /θ/ (voiceless 'th')

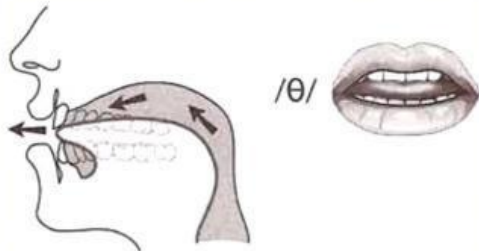

Listen and repeat: /θ/.

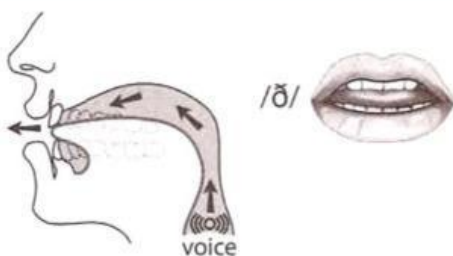


Consonant sound /ð/ (voiced 'th') as in "this"
