An object pronoun is used in place of the noun that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.

Person	Singular Object Pronouns	Plural Object Pronouns
1st (speaking)	me	us
2nd (being spoken to)	you	you
3rd (being spoken about)	him/her/it	them
