- Bị động ở thì tương lai được sử dụng khi chúng ta đề cập đến điều gì đó được thực hiện bởi ai đó trong tương lai.

Positive	S + will + be + P.P + (by + agent).	Ex: This letter will be sent tomorrow.
Negative	S + will + not + be + P.P + (by + agent).	Ex: A new computer will not be bought by Jane.
Question	Will + S + be + P.P + (by + agent)? Wh + will + S + be + P.P + (by + agent)?	Ex: Will this cat be kept by Jane? When will the patient be examined by the doctor?

***Note:** P.P = past participle: quá khứ phân từ; by + agent = by + đối tượng thực hiện hành động.
