Direct Speech	Indirect Speech
I	he/she
me	him/her
my	his/her
mine	his/hers
myself	himself/herself
we	they
us	them
our	their
ours	theirs
ourselves	themselves
you (ประธาน)	he/she
you (กรรม)	me

- Jacob: "I work in an office."  
Jacob told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ worked in an office.
- Alan and Lucas: "We play football."  
Alan and Lucas told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ played football.
- Victoria: "I like my cat."  
Victoria told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ liked cat.
- Henry: "Can you see me?"  
Henry asked me if he / I could see him/ me .
- Julia: "I will have to borrow your pencil."  
Julia told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ would have to borrow \_\_\_\_\_pencil.
- Melanie: "My father is Jamaican."  
Melanie told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ father is Jamaican.
- Emma and Aliz: "Can we use your camera?"  
Emma and Aliz asked me if \_\_\_\_\_ could use \_\_\_\_\_camera.
- Andrew: "How is your journey?"  
Andrew asked me how \_\_\_\_\_ journey was.
- Isabella and Ella: "We love our pets."  
Isabella and Ella told me (that) \_\_\_\_\_ loved \_\_\_\_\_pets.
- Aunt: "Please bring me a cup of my tea."  
Aunt told me to bring \_\_\_\_\_ a cup of \_\_\_\_\_ tea.
