fall out with sb	become popular or fashionable
find sth out	find/ meet sb by chance

get away with sth	like each other on the first meeting
get by	give information to a lot of people
get on with sb	recover from
get over sth	continue
give away information	manage to survive/ live
give homework in	return sth
give in (to sb's requests)	go somewhere
give oneself up	travel around
give out (book/paper)	drink sth very quickly
give out information	manage to do sth bad without being punished or criticised for
give sth back	stop doing sth you do regularly
give sth up	hand homework to the teacher
go in for (a competition)	allow oneself to be arrested
go on	tell information that should be kept secret
go on (with sth)	enter (a competition)
go round	have a good relationship with sb
grow up	distribute sth to several people
gulp sth down	visit a person or place
head for somewhere	agree to sth after initial resistance
hit it off with sb	change from being a child to becoming an adult
