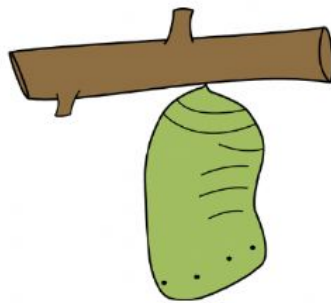
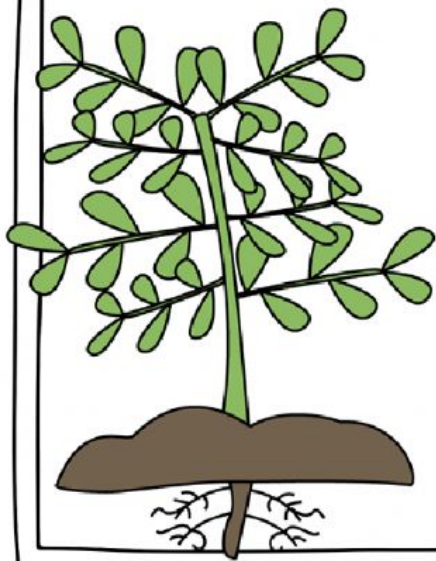
Things do not just happen; there are causal relationships at work, and actions have consequences.



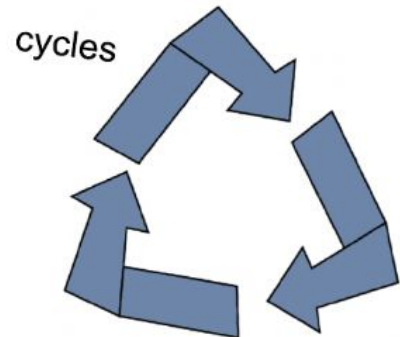

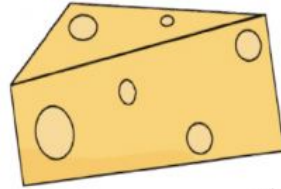


We live in a world of interacting systems in which the actions of any individual element affect others.

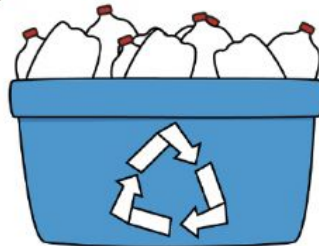

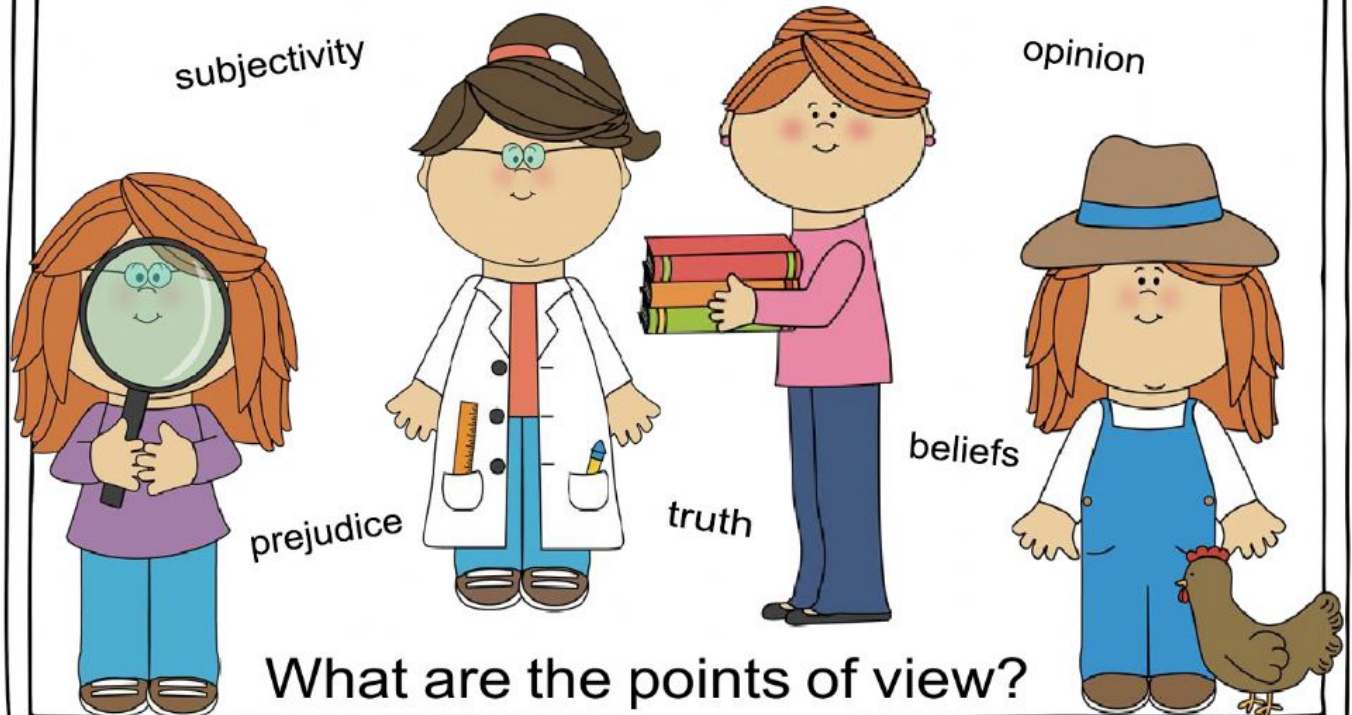

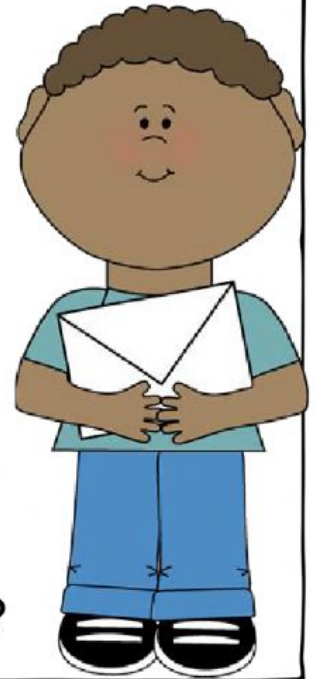
