$$\begin{array}{r} \text{a)} \quad 3.8 \\ \times \quad 2 \\ \hline 7.6 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{b)} \quad 1.21 \\ \times \quad 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{c)} \quad 2.6 \\ \times \quad 3.2 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{d)} \quad 2.12 \\ \times \quad 5.7 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{e)} \quad 3.26 \\ \times \quad 1.6 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
