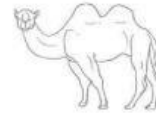


Camels



Camels are large animals that have humps on their backs. One kind of camels [1]_____ called the Arabian camel. It has just one hump. The Bactrian camel, [2]_____, has two. These two camels have some important features in common. They both [3]____very strong backs, can live for days without drinking water and are able to live on a very poor diet. As a result, this type of camel has thick hair which is shed in spring when [10]_____is unnecessary in the warm weather.
