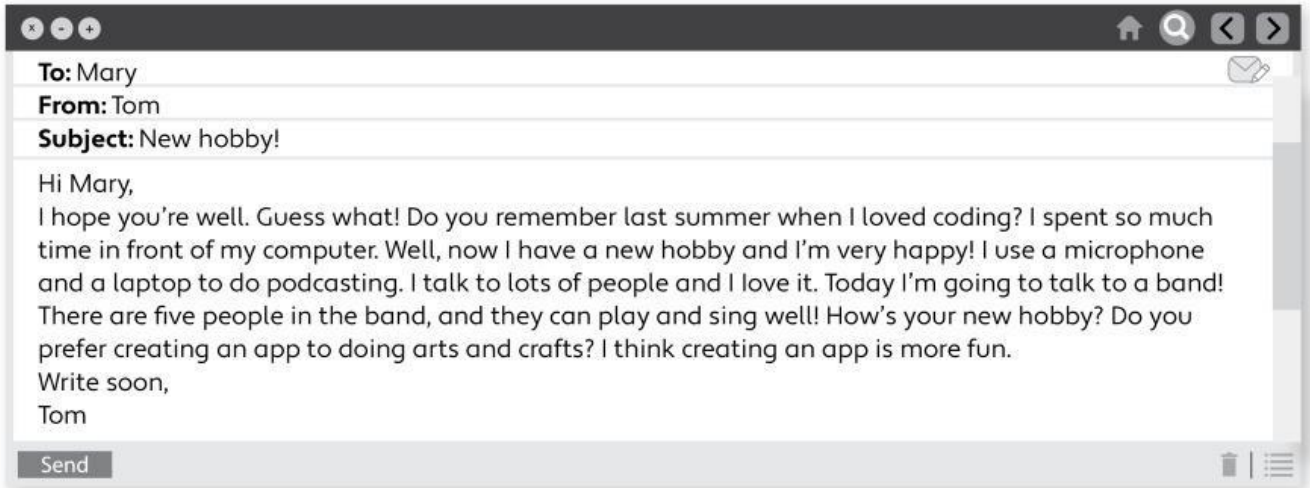

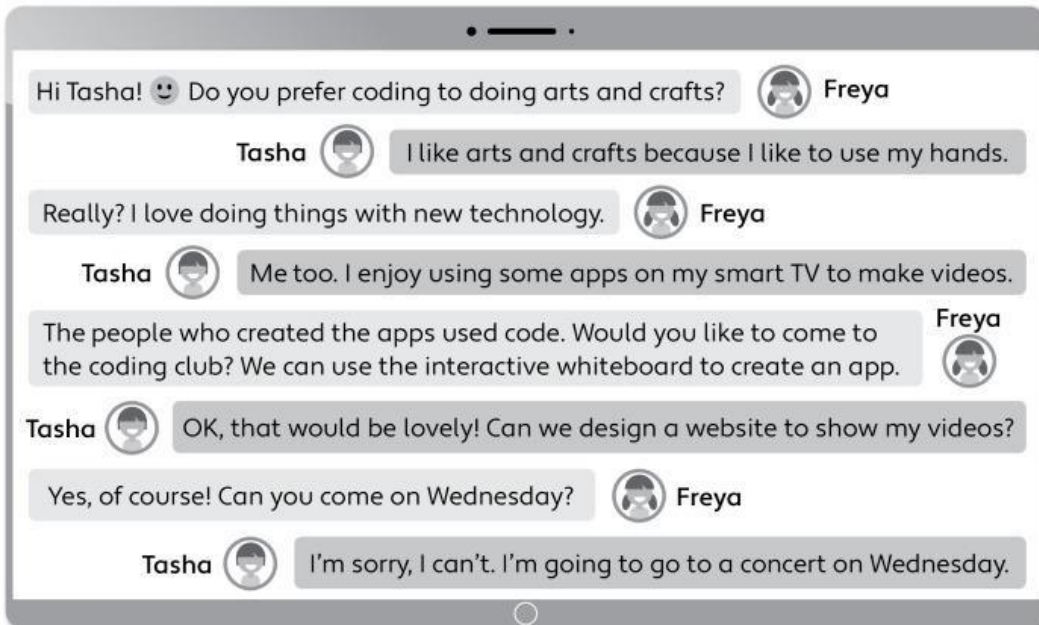

Speaking

Teaching notes

For each item, award one point for accuracy and one point for ability to communicate well.

Activity 7 asks pupils to use verbs of preference with gerunds. Ask pupils to look at the pictures and name the different hobbies. Then have them look at what each smiley symbol means. Have pupils talk about each person, focusing on the correct grammatical structure.

Activity 8 asks pupils to produce the vocabulary items from this unit using the structures *Do you (use) ... to ...?* and *You/I (use) ... to ...*

Ask pupils to look at the pictures and name the different hobbies in box 1 and the objects in box 2. Give them time to think of some possible questions about the hobbies/objects in the pictures, using *use*, *need* or *wear*. Then have them work in pairs and take turns to ask and answer questions about the hobbies and objects, using the structures *Do you (use) ... to ...?* *You/I (use) ... to ...*. Explain to pupils that they can answer using either the generic 'you' (meaning people in general) or the first person 'I', if they have experience of doing that hobby themselves. They should each ask or answer five questions. Encourage stronger pupils to add further details about their own hobbies and experiences.

7 Look and say.

Example answer: *Anna prefers coding to podcasting. She can't stand playing in a band. She loves trampolining, and she really likes doing arts and crafts.*

8 Ask and answer using *use*, *need* or *wear*.

Example questions/answers: **A:** *Do you use a microphone to play in a band?* **B:** *Yes, the singer uses a microphone to sing songs.*

B: *Do traffic lights need code to work?* **A:** *Yes, they do. Smart TVs need code, too.*

A: *Do you wear boots to go trampolining?* **B:** *No, you don't need to wear shoes or boots!*

B: *Do you need soil to do gardening?* **A:** *Yes, you need soil to grow flowers and plants.*

A: *Do you use beads to do arts and crafts?* **B:** *No, I don't. I use paper and pencils.*
