 You now or you'll miss the train.
- 41 He usually gets home before I do.
GET
 He home before I do.
- 42 Dave goes running at 7 o'clock every morning despite it still being dark at that time.
EVEN
 Dave goes running at 7 o'clock every morning still dark at that time.
