Maps and Satellites

Maps and satellites help us understand places on Earth. A map is a drawing that shows different places, like cities, countries, rivers, and mountains. People use maps to find directions and to see where things are. Maps often use symbols to show things like roads, parks, and buildings.

A satellite is a machine that goes around Earth in space. Satellites take photos of Earth from above. These photos are called satellite images. Satellite images show everything on the ground, like houses, forests, and oceans. People use satellite images to learn about weather, track storms, and see how places look from space.

Maps and satellite images are both helpful, but they are different. Maps show only some things, like roads or parks, and use symbols. Satellite images show everything in a place, like a real photo. Both maps and satellite images help us find our way and learn more about the world.
