Động từ khuyết thiếu:

can, could, may, might, will, shall, would,
must, have to, need, should, ought to,
had better, used to.



Cấu trúc chung

S + modal verbs + V (bare infinitive)



Types of Modal verbs

Ability

Can - Can't

★ Khả năng, năng lực có thể làm gì ở hiện tại.

Could - Couldn't

★ Khả năng, năng lực có thể làm gì trong quá khứ.

E.g. My sister can play the guitar.
I can't speak Chinese.
He could swim at the age of five.
I couldn't talk when I was two.



Advice

Should - Shouldn't

Ought to - Ought not to

Had better - Had better not

★ Hỏi xin và đưa ra lời khuyên



E.g. You should drink more water.
Should we go out tonight?
He ought not to eat too much chocolate.

Obligation

MUST - phải làm gì

★ Người nói thấy bản thân, ai phải làm gì. (quan điểm cá nhân - tác nhân bên trong)

HAVE TO - phải làm gì

★ Quy định, luật lệ, tình hình thực tế, sự thật. (tác nhân bên ngoài)

Hiện tại: have to - has to

Tương lai: will have to

Quá khứ: had to

E.g. I must study harder for the final exam.
I have to wear a uniform when going to school.
I had to work long hours when I worked for that company.





Necessity

Cần thiết làm gì

Need + V

Need + to V (need chia theo thì)

Không cần thiết làm gì

Needn't + V

Don't/ Doesn't/ Didn't need + to V

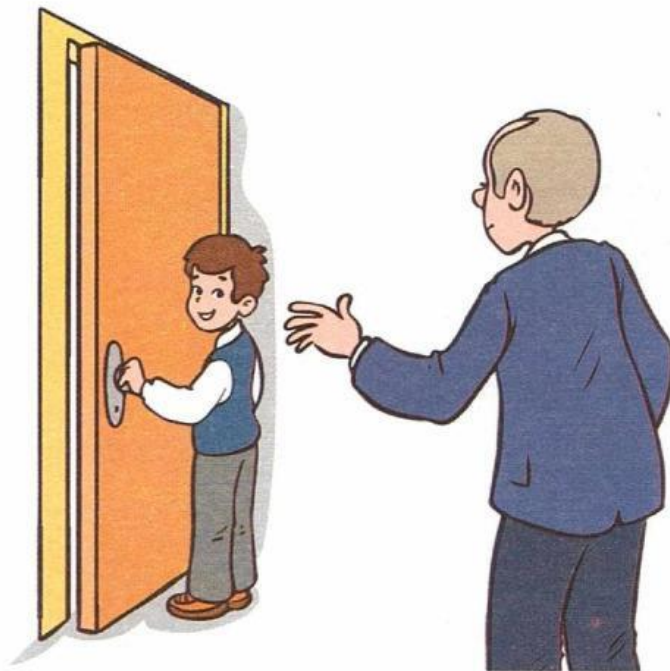
Don't/ Doesn't/ Didn't have to + V

E.g. He needs to go out now.
I needn't clean the house.
I don't need / have to clean the house.

Prohibition

Mustn't - cấm làm gì

E.g. You mustn't enter this room.

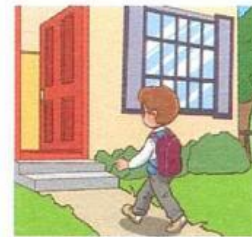
