Past Simple: Questions

- To make yes/no questions, we put the verb **did** before the subject.
- To make wh-questions, we put question words at the beginning of sentences.



Question			Answer	
Yes/No Question	Did	you	Yes, I did .	No, I didn't .
	Did	he	Yes, he did .	No, he didn't .
	Did	they	Yes, they did .	No, they didn't .
Wh-question	What	did you	eat for lunch?	I ate a pie for lunch.
	Where	did he	eat lunch?	He ate lunch in the cafeteria .
	When	did they	eat lunch?	They ate lunch at noon .



Did you go camping yesterday?

– Yes, I **did**.

Did you go with your friends?

– No, I **didn't**.



What did you see last night?

– I saw **shooting stars**.

Where did you see them?

– I saw them **in the field**.


