of: take care of

for: prepare for smth (but prepare **to V1**), wait for

at: at the age of, at high pace, arrive at + 'place' (e.g. arrive at the station), look at

in: in advance, arrive in + 'country, city' (e.g. arrive in Chile)

as: the same as

to: listen to, look forward to, equal to

No preposition: enter smth, paint smth + 'colour', answer the questions, go home, leave home, call sb etc.
