

TYPES OF CONJUNCTION

Types of conjunctions are coordinating conjunctions, subordinating conjunctions, and correlative conjunctions.

- **Coordinating conjunctions** are *and, or, but, nor, yet, so, and for.*
- **Subordinating conjunctions** are *after, although, as, as if, because, before, how, if, since, than, though, unless, until, when, where, and while.*
- **Correlative conjunctions** are *either/or, neither/nor, both/and, whether/or, and not only/but also.*
