The Tale of the Three Brothers

Three brothers once traveled together on a quiet, winding road at twilight. They came upon a deep and dangerous river, one that would drown anyone who tried to cross. But the brothers, skilled in magic, used their wands to create a bridge and began to walk across. Halfway over, they were met by a hooded figure: it was Death, angry that the brothers had escaped him. However, Death pretended to be impressed and offered each brother a gift of their choice.



The eldest brother, who was very proud and combative, wanted a wand more powerful than any other. Death went to a nearby elder tree and created the Elder Wand for him. The second brother, arrogant and desiring power over Death, asked for the ability to bring people back from the dead. Death picked a stone from the river and made it the Resurrection Stone. Finally, the youngest brother, who was wise and humble, didn't trust Death and asked for something to help him escape Death's grasp. Death, unwillingly, gave him his own Invisibility Cloak.

With their gifts, the brothers went their separate ways. The eldest went to a village and, wanting revenge on an enemy, used the Elder Wand to defeat him in a duel. Later, the eldest boasted about his powerful wand at an inn, but that night, he was killed in his sleep by a thief who stole the wand. Thus, Death took the first brother.

The second brother returned home and used the Resurrection Stone to bring back the woman he once loved. She appeared but seemed distant, as if separated from him by a veil, and she was unhappy. Eventually, the second brother, unable to endure her sadness, took his own life to join her in death. And so, Death took the second brother.

Many years passed, and Death searched for the youngest brother, but he could never find him. It was only when the youngest brother had lived a long, full life that he finally removed the Invisibility Cloak and gave it to his son. A. Veritaserum is a powerful truth serum. The potion effectively forces the drinker to answer any questions put to them truthfully, though there are certain methods of resistance. Use of this potion is strictly controlled by the British Ministry of Magic. Veritaserum was used on Barty Crouch Jr in June of 1995, when Albus Dumbledore discovered that Crouch was disguised as the Defence Against the Dark Arts teacher, Alastor Moody.

B. If there's one thing stronger than young love, it's this love potion. Think of the incorrigible Romilda Vane and then picture Ron Weasley's dazed face when he ate the chocolates she meant for Harry. Amortentia was the most potent love potion in the world and no one was immune. Even know-it-all Hermione got an attack of blushing embarrassment when she caught the scent of it during Potions class.

C. Polyjuice Potion was a thick, powerful tonic with serious consequences if you mixed it wrong. Harry, Hermione and Ron first tasted some when they went undercover as Draco Malfoy's sidekicks. Members of the Order of the Phoenix drank it to disguise themselves as Harry Potters, and it also helped Harry, Hermione and Ron break into the Ministry of Magic. Hermione discovered that a stray cat hair could cause an unwelcome transformation.

D. Funny really. While adults spend a fortune to look younger, teenagers spend years trying to be more grown-up than they really are. When Fred and George discovered they were too young to enter their names for the Triwizard Tournament, they decided that a few drops of Ageing Potion would do the trick. The twins only got long white beards that had to be magically removed by Madam Pomfrey.

E. Felix Felicis, also called "Liquid Luck", is a magical potion that makes the drinker lucky for a period of time, during which everything they attempt will be successful. It turns an ordinary day into an extraordinary one. It causes dizziness, recklessness, and dangerous overconfidence if taken in excess. Felix is highly toxic in large quantities and is also a banned substance in all organised competitions, such as Quidditch.


