Inland landscapes	Coastal landscapes

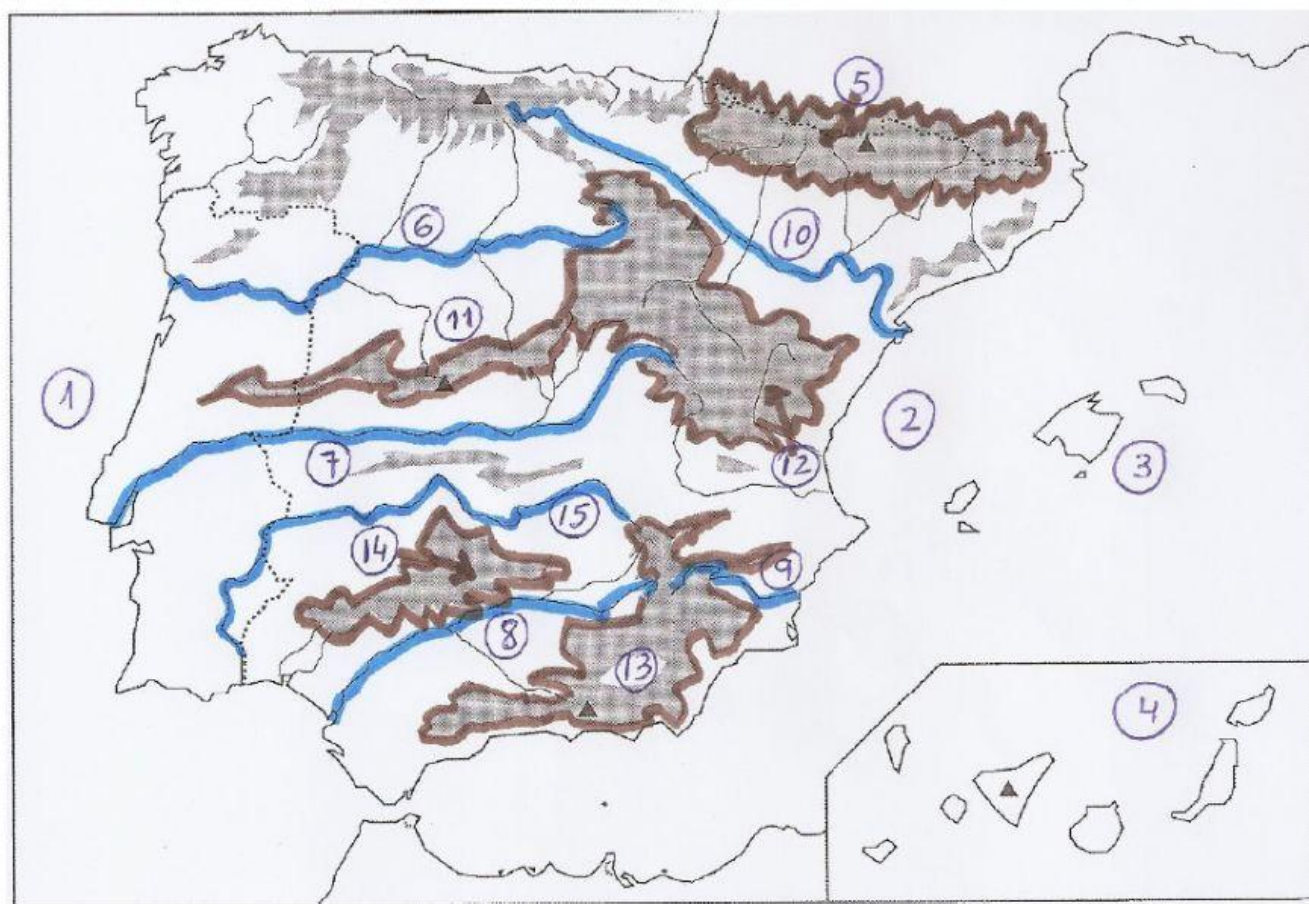
3. Match these landscapes with their definitions
