In many places, people face different health problems. Some people can have an ear infection, which causes pain in their ears. Also, some can get an allergic reaction to things which cause skin rashes like pollen (*phân hoa*) or food. Another problem is chest infection which makes people feel hard to breathe. Mosquitoes are also dangerous because they bite people and spread (*lây lan*) illness like malaria. To protect ourselves, we can use insect repellent and burn mosquito coils to keep mosquitoes away. Sleeping under a mosquito net is another useful way. Mosquitoes live in warm, wet habitats where they lay eggs. Keeping our houses clean and dry is important to keep us safe and help reduce mosquitoes' lifespan.


