



PRESENT SIMPLE


We use Present Simple to talk about habits (things we do with a certain frequency). It is usually accompanied by adverbs of time, such as **always**, **every day/week/month sometimes**, **often**, **once a week**, **twice a week**, **never**... Some verbs, such as **love**, **hate** or **like**, are always in the Present Simple.
