Throughout his years at Hogwarts, Harry faces other threats, including the giant basilisk in the Chamber of Secrets, and the Dementors in the Prisoner of Azkaban. Each challenge helps Harry grow stronger, preparing himself for the ultimate battle against Voldemort.

The story of Harry Potter is about more than magic; it's about the power of love, friendship, and courage to overcome even the darkest of times.

B. Read the descriptions below, which are all summaries of scenes from the *Avengers: Age of Ultron* movie.

A Harry, Ron, and Hermione embark on a dangerous journey to find and destroy Voldemort's Horcruxes, which are objects containing pieces of his soul. These charmed items are hidden across dangerous locations, requiring the three friends to use their courage, magical skills, and imagination. As they face challenges such as cursed objects, dark creatures, and Voldemort's followers, their friendship is strengthened. Each Horcrux they destroy weakens Voldemort's power, bringing them one-step closer to ending his reign of terror.

B On his eleventh birthday, Harry discovers he is a wizard when Hagrid visits him and delivers his Hogwarts acceptance letter. Leaving behind a life of neglect with the Dursleys, Harry enters a magical world filled with wonder and excitement. At Hogwarts, he is sorted into Gryffindor and meets Ron Weasley and Hermione Granger. He begins his magical education, learning about spells, potions, and the secrets of the wizarding world. Then, he discovers the truth about his parents and Voldemort's role in their deaths.

C When Ginny Weasley goes missing, Harry discovers she has been taken to the Chamber of Secrets by Voldemort's enchanted diary. With the help of Fawkes, Dumbledore's phoenix, and the Sorting Hat, which provides him with the Sword of Gryffindor, Harry descends into the chamber. There, he confronts the enormous basilisk, a deadly serpent under Voldemort's control. Harry battles courageously, using the sword to kill the creature and destroy the diary, saving Ginny and putting an end to the terror that threatens Hogwarts.

D While Harry and Hermione were hiding near the lake during their time-travel and rescue mission, Harry and Hermione watch helplessly as Dementors close in on his past self and Sirius Black. Using all his strength and happy memories, Harry casts a powerful Patronus charm in the form of a stag. The brilliant light drives the Dementors away, saving both Sirius and his younger self from their soul-sucking attack. This moment marks Harry's mastery of the difficult spell and highlights his deep connection to his parents' legacy.

E During the epic Battle of Hogwarts, Harry confronts Voldemort in the Great Hall. With all Horcruxes destroyed, Voldemort's power is diminished. In their final duel, Harry uses his mastery of defensive spells and his knowledge of wand experience to defeat Voldemort once and for all. As Voldemort's Killing Curse rebounds upon him due to his broken wand and arrogance, the Dark Lord falls, ending his reign of terror. Harry's victory brings peace to the wizarding world and strengthens his legacy as its liberator.
