Lena: Good morning Sir. My name is Lena Tobar. How can I help you?

John: Good morning Ms. Tobar. I am John Barclay. I lost my job last year as a police officer and I have not found anything related to my profession.

Lena: Of course Mr. Barklay. You are in the right place. What is your profession exactly?

John: Well, I have a bachelor's degree in criminal justice.

Lena: You have a lot of options, Mr. Barclay.

John: Oh I'm glad you say that.

Lena: Yes, there are many options. If you have already worked for a couple of years you can earn up to \$ 58,720 annually.

John: It is a good option. What other options are there?

Lena: Have you ever worked at prisons, jails, or probation agencies?

John: No, I have not.

Lena: You can work as a staff or a probation officer. The opportunities to get a job as a probation officer have increased in recent years. The average salary of a probation officer is \$ 40,000 per year. Another option is to work as a forensic scientist. A forensic scientist analyzes blood, crime scenes, DNA, and more. The average salary is \$ 56,750 annually. However, you need to be comfortable with a microscope and an interview room. What about security? Have you ever worked in private security? It is not a simple job. You must prevent crime and economic loss and handle emergencies. But the salary can be good. A security guard earns approximately \$ 13.10 per hour or \$27,240 annually.
