

# PAST SIMPLE

We use the Past Simple Tense when talking about actions that happened at a specific time in the past.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I <b>ate</b> .	I <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> I eat?
You <b>ate</b> .	You <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> you eat?
We <b>ate</b> .	We <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> we eat?
They <b>ate</b> .	They <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> they eat?
He <b>ate</b> .	He <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> he eat?
She <b>ate</b> .	She <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> she eat?
It <b>ate</b> .	It <b>didn't</b> eat.	<b>Did</b> it eat?
