Strange sports

You have probably heard of chess and the sport of boxing, but have you heard of chess boxing? This is one of the more **unusual** sports that people play. It started in the early 1990s in the Netherlands. It consists of one round of chess followed by one round of boxing. The first player to win either at chess or boxing, wins the chess boxing **match**. The sport is now considered to be a competitive sport, and it is **popular** in the UK and Germany. Can you believe it?

There is also a sport called wife carrying. I think you can guess what this is. In this sport, men have to run around an obstacle course in the quickest time possible, usually carrying their wife around their neck. The sport started in Finland and is now played in many countries, but Finland organizes the world championships every year. A competitor doesn't have to carry his own wife but can actually carry anyone's wife! The only rule is that the "wife" has to be over 17 years old and weigh at least 49 kilograms.

Another strange sport is egg throwing. The idea is you have to throw an egg as far as you can without **breaking** it. Believe it or not, some clever kids in Germany worked out a way to spin an egg as they threw it so that it landed on its end still **spinning** and not broken!
