be interested in sth

ARE you INTO literature?

take up

start doing a new activity

Chris has TAKEN UP jogging.

fall behind

make less progress than others

My daughter is FALLING BEHIND with her school work.

catch up with

improve and reach the same standard as other people

I need to CATCH UP WITH Jane.

go over

1. check something
2. practise and repeat something in order to learn it

Could you GO OVER this report?
Let's GO OVER our lines for the play.



read up on

study or learn sth by reading

I need to READ UP ON Malawi.

hand in / turn in

give your finished work to a teacher

She HANDED IN / TURNED IN her essay.

hand out

give sth to each person in a group

The teacher HANDED OUT the worksheets.

copy out

write sth again exactly as it was written

We always COPY OUT sentences from a book.

drop out

stop going to a school before finishing it

She DROPPED OUT of college and went straight into a job.
