

We use the Past Perfect Tense when talking about actions that happened before another action in the past.

<b>POSITIVE</b>	<b>NEGATIVE</b>	<b>QUESTION</b>
I <b>had</b> eaten.	I <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> I eaten?
He <b>had</b> eaten.	He <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> he eaten?
She <b>had</b> eaten.	She <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> she eaten?
It <b>had</b> eaten.	It <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> it eaten?
We <b>had</b> eaten.	We <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> we eaten?
You <b>had</b> eaten.	You <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> you eaten?
They <b>had</b> eaten.	They <b>hadn't</b> eaten.	<b>Had</b> they eaten?
