- In 1823 General Bolivar sent General Jose de Sucre to fight with royalty army in Peru. Then, General Jose de la Serna followed the patriot's army.
- In 1824 General Jose de la Serna marched from Cuzco with his army.
- On 9 December 1824 in Pampa de Quinua 5780 patriot soldiers fought with 6906 royalty soldiers.
- Before midday, the patriot's army caught General Jose de la Serna.
- The Battle ended with a victory of patriot's army to led General Jose de Sucre.
- That afternoon, General Canterac, representing General José de la Serna, signed the Capitulation of Ayacucho.
