

## Top 10 Slang words

### 1. Study the words and their definitions

- **Salty:** Being upset, annoyed, or bitter about something.  
*Example: "He's still salty about losing that game."*
- **Dough:** Slang for money.  
*Example: "I need to save up some dough for my trip."*
- **Spill:** To share gossip or information. Often used with "the tea."  
*Example: "Come on, spill! What happened at the party?"*
- **Throw shade:** To criticize or insult someone subtly.  
*Example: "Did you see her post? She was totally throwing shade at him."*
- **Boujee:** Someone or something fancy or high-class, sometimes pretentiously so.  
*Example: "She's so boujee, always showing off her designer bags."*
- **Lit:** Something exciting, amazing, or fun.  
*Example: "That concert was lit!"*
- **Flex:** To show off, especially material possessions or achievements.  
*Example: "He's always flexing his new car on Instagram."*
- **Crash:** To fall asleep quickly or unplanned, often from exhaustion.  
*Example: "After that hike, I just crashed on the couch."*
- **Ghost:** To suddenly cut off all communication with someone.  
*Example: "We were talking every day, then he just ghosted me."*
- **Vibe:** The mood or atmosphere of a person, place, or situation.  
*Example: "This café has such a chill vibe."*
