

Worksheet: Practicing the Pattern 'The way + Person + Verb'

Pattern Explanation

In English, we use the structure 'The way + Person + Verb' to describe how someone does something. This can express opinions (positive or negative) or give descriptions.

Structure:

The way + [Person] + [Verb] + (optional details)

Examples:

- I love the way he plays the guitar.
- The way she smiles makes everyone happy.
- They do not like the way you talk to them.
