A modern genius

Stephen Hawking was one of the most famous scientists in the world. He was born in Oxford in 1942 and lived there till the moment he moved to Cambridge to complete his PhD. Before this, however, people already knew that he was intelligent. He enjoyed Maths and Science in school very much. He found both subjects very easy, and it was while he was studying there that his friends began to call him 'Einstein', for fun.

Stephen's first university was actually Oxford, where he studied Physics and Chemistry. During his studies there, at the age of 21, he became very sick and had problems with speaking and moving. When he realised he was extremely ill, he decided to work harder. This was because he really wanted to finish his PhD before he died.

Hawking finished his PhD when he was only 24. Later he wrote over 15 very popular science books. His doctors didn't expect him to live long. He died at the age of 76 – definitely too early, as many say.

An inspiration to everyone

The 2012 London Olympics were a chance for the whole country to celebrate Britain's multicultural society. The person I am writing about is my inspiration because he represented modern Britain better than any other athlete.

Mo Farah was born in Somalia, East Africa, in 1983. His father had British citizenship, so Mo moved to Britain when he was eight years old. He arrived in a foreign country and, what's more, he spoke almost no English. His P.E. teacher soon noticed that he was good at running and Mo joined a local athletics club.

He won five school championships and, after that, he started winning medals in adult competitions, but he achieved widespread popularity after the Olympics, when he won two gold medals in the 10,000 metre and 5,000 metre races. Because of his success and a happy smiling face, he became the symbol of Britain's Olympic team.

Mo Farah's success continued after the Olympics and, four years later in Rio, he won two more gold medals for the same distances. In the 10,000 metres, he fell at one point after another runner bumped into him, but got up and still won the race!

Mo urodził się w Somalii, we Wschodniej Afryce, w 1983 roku. Jego ojciec ¹ _____ i Mo w wieku ośmiu lat przeniósł się do Wielkiej Brytanii. Na początku prawie nie mówił po angielsku, ale jego talent ² _____ został szybko zauważony i chłopak już wkrótce zaczął chodzić na zajęcia lokalnego klubu sportowego.

Zanim zaczął zdobywać medale w zawodach dla dorosłych, Mo wygrał ³ _____. Ogromna popularność przyniosły mu jednak dopiero igrzyska olimpijskie, podczas których zdobył dwa złote medale. Na kolejnej olimpiadzie, w Rio, powtórzył swój sukces z Londynu, mimo że w biegu na 10 000 metrów przewrócił się, po tym jak ⁴ _____ inny biegacz. Zdołał się jednak podnieść i dobiec do mety jako pierwszy!


