- *Discuss two main points (use the notes given).*
- *Support your argument with examples from the story.*
- *Use linking words to connect your ideas.*
- *End with a conclusion that summarizes your opinion.*

Take these questions into consideration if you feel lost or uninspired when writing:

- 1. Why do you think Taylor and Danielle chose to take justice into their own hands?**
- 2. How does the story challenge traditional ideas of justice and morality?**
- 3. Would you have made the same decisions as Taylor and Danielle? Why or why not?**
