## MATILDE HIDALGO

Matilde Hidalgo was born in Loja-Ecuador on September 29, 1889. From an early age, she wanted to be somebody important. But at that time, education was a privilege for boys. As a result, it was hard for her to enter high school, and to finally graduate in 1913 because she had to resist all kinds of discrimination from authorities, classmates and parents for her condition of woman.

However, Matilde's aspirations were big, and a high school diploma was not enough; she wanted to study medicine at Central University. Of course, men opposed to her plans in Quito, but the Medicine School of the University of Azuay accepted her, and she became the first woman professional in Ecuador. After that, her fight continued over her life, but she was finally recognized around the country and Latin America as a strong woman destined to be a pioneer in different areas. For example, she was the first woman to vote and be elected to the congress. All in all, her character was her most surprising feature in times when only men dominated, and this is what made her an extraordinary person. She died in Guayaquil in 1974.
