I ----- AM  
+ You/We/They ----- ARE  
He/She/It ----- IS

I ----- AM NOT  
- You/We/They --- ARE NOT/AREN'T  
He/She/It ----- IS NOT / ISN'T

AM ----- I?  
ARE ----- You/We/They?  
IS ----- He/She/It?

# HAVE GOT

## Tener

+ I/You/We/They ----- HAVE GOT  
He/She/It ----- HAS GOT

- I/You/We/They --- HAVEN'T GOT  
(have not got)  
He/She/It ----- HASN'T GOT  
(has not got)

? HAVE --- I/ You/We/They --- GOT?  
HAS ----- He/She/It ----- GOT?
