For nearly 50 years, the Rotterdam Film Festival in the Netherlands has shown unusual and exciting film projects from around the world. The organizers of the festival are creative and positive people. For example, when award-winning movie director Apichatpong Weerasethakul wanted to show a movie that lasted for more than 24 hours, the organizers said, "No problem." Apichatpong also wanted to create a hotel inside the movie theater. Could the theater provide beds and showers, and give the guests breakfast? "No problem."

The result of this discussion is the Sleep Cinema Hotel. Six small beds are arranged in front of a movie screen. The beds are on a metal structure so they are above the floor, like birds' nests.
