<b>Định nghĩa</b>	- Động từ kép gồm <b>một động từ</b> và một hoặc hai <b>tiểu từ</b> (trạng từ hoặc giới từ).	
<b>Phân loại</b>	<b>Động từ kép có thể phân cách</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nếu tân ngữ là <b>đại từ</b> thì luôn <b>đứng giữa động từ và tiểu từ</b>.</li> <li><u>E.g.</u> The light is on. Turn <u>it</u> off.</li> <li>Nếu tân ngữ là <b>danh từ</b> thì có thể đứng <b>trước</b> hoặc <b>sau tiểu từ</b>.</li> <li><u>E.g.</u> He is <u>trying a jacket</u> on. or He is <u>trying on a jacket</u>.</li> </ul>
	<b>Động từ kép không thể phân cách</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tân ngữ luôn <b>đứng sau tiểu từ</b>.</li> <li><u>E.g.</u> You should <u>look after your old parents</u>.</li> </ul>
