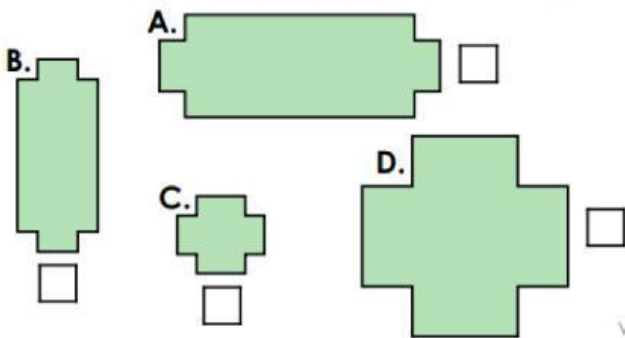

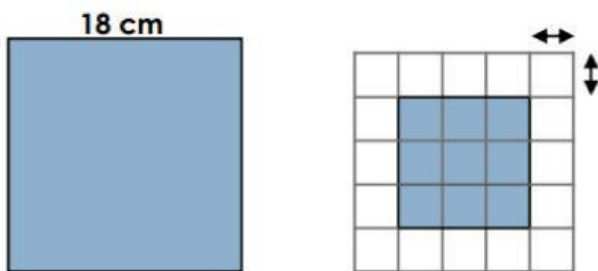

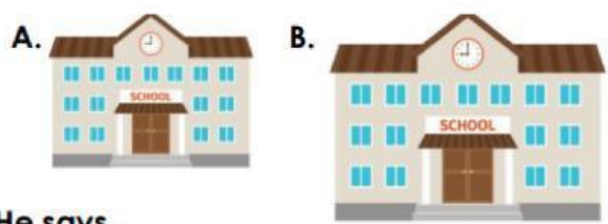

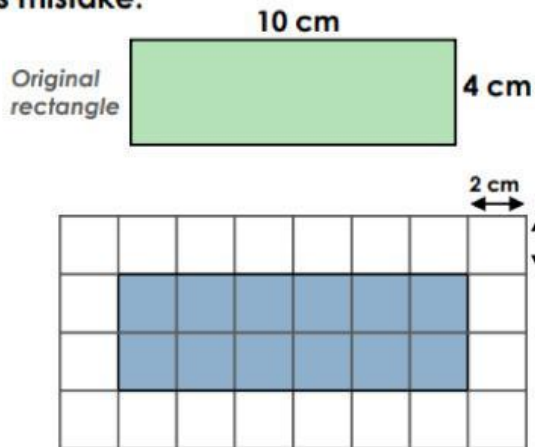


Picture B is a scale drawing of picture A because both have the same proportions.

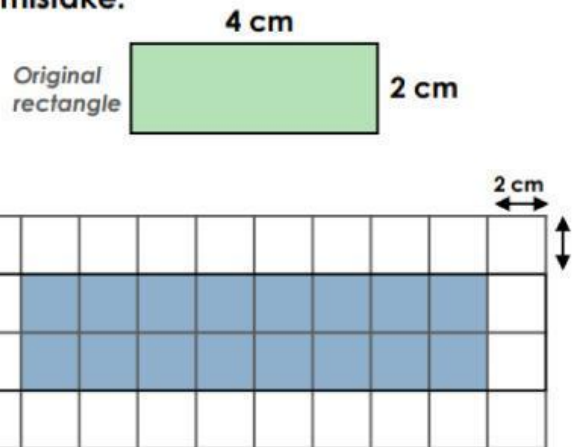
