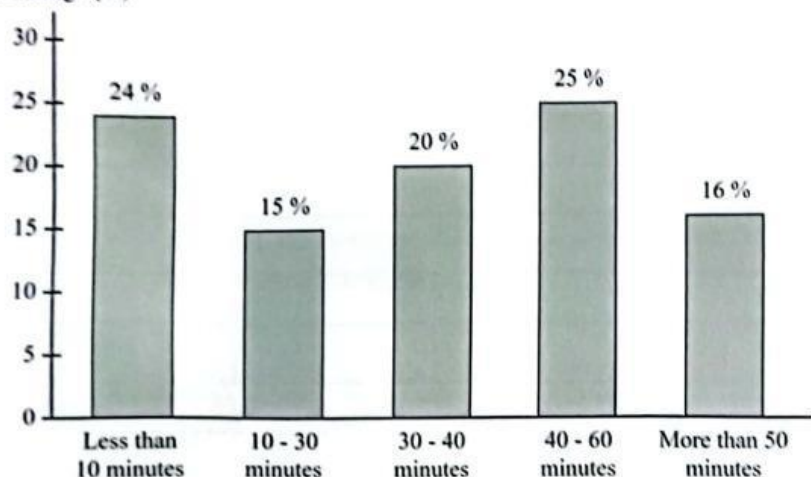
### Smartphone as the Car Key

Voice control devices such as Alexa, Siri and Google Home may act as “friends” and **help to improve children’s reading and communication skills**, however their advanced AI and “human”-sounding voices have prompted concerns about the **potential long-term effects on children’s brains at a crucial stage of development**.

These devices might have **long-term effects by impeding children’s critical thinking, capacity for empathy and compassion, and their learning skills**, says Dr Anmol Arora, an academic physician at the University of Cambridge in the United Kingdom.
