

**GRAMMAR****Past Simple: was/were**

+ I **was** out.  
She **was** excited.  
We **were** at the zoo.

– I **wasn't** at the shops.  
She **wasn't** shocked.  
We **weren't** at home.

?	Were you at the shops?	Yes, I <b>was</b> ./No, I <b>wasn't</b> .
	Was it fun?	Yes, it <b>was</b> ./No, it <b>wasn't</b> .
	Were they excited?	Yes, we <b>were</b> ./No, we <b>weren't</b> .

Where **were** you?

+ there is/are → there **was/were**

– there isn't/aren't → there **wasn't/weren't**

**Time expressions:** *last night/weekend, yesterday, this morning, two days ago, at ten o'clock*
