Ends with consonant + y	→	easy	:	easier
Ends with consonant + vowel + consonant	→	thin	:	thinner

dangerous	:	more dangerous
expensive	:	more expensive

Irregular Adjectives

good	:	better
bad	:	worse
far	:	farther/further
