<b>all</b>	tất cả	X	X	- <b>All</b> students love English. - <b>All</b> the water here is clean.
<b>any</b>	bất kỳ, một số	X	X	- Do you have <b>any</b> books? - There isn't <b>any</b> water left.

## 2. Could / Couldn't

Could / Couldn't		
Cách dùng	Chỉ khả năng thực hiện điều gì đó tại một thời điểm trong quá khứ	
(+)	She <b>could</b> the homework on time.	You <b>could</b> win that game.
(-)	He <b>couldn't</b> visit my grandparents.	They <b>couldn't</b> go out yesterday.
(?)	<b>Could</b> she help him with his homework? - Yes, she <b>could</b> . / No, she <b>couldn't</b> .	<b>Could</b> you come there last night? - Yes, I <b>could</b> . / No, I <b>couldn't</b> .

**Chú thích:** S = subject: chủ ngữ; V = verb infinitives: động từ nguyên thể.

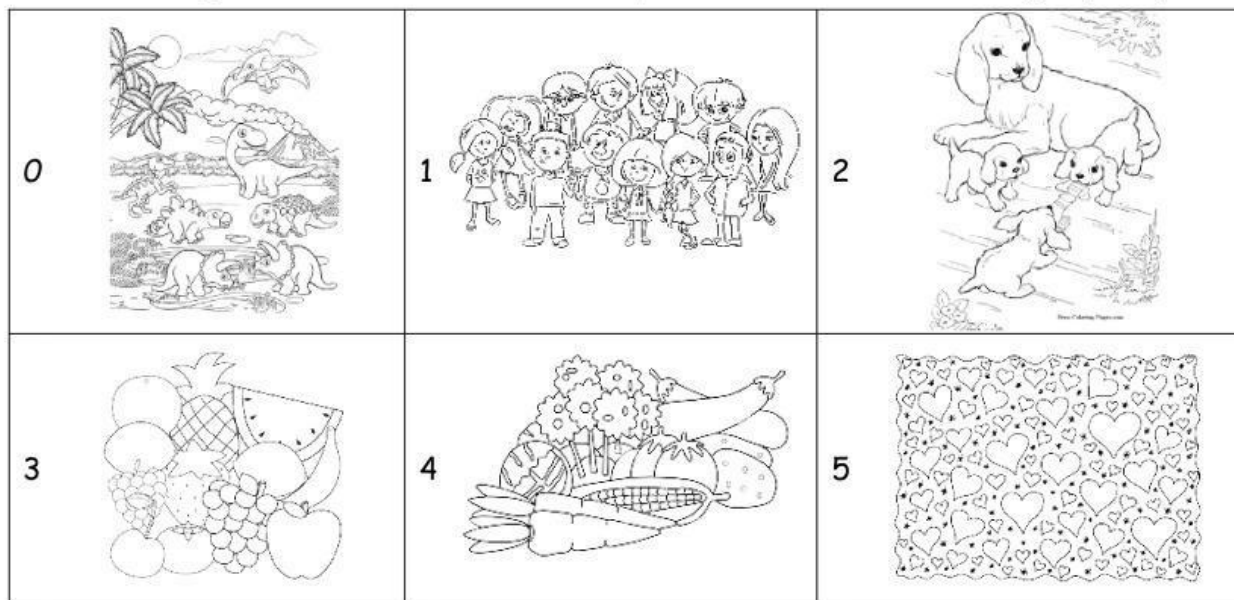
