### ace - addend

**ace** \ās\ **1** *n* A playing card with one symbol in its center  
**2** *n*. A person who is an expert at something [a flying *ace*]  
**3** *adj* Of the very best kind [an *ace* reporter]  
**ache** \āk\ **1** *vb* to suffer a dull continuous pain **2** *vb* to desire very much [She *aches* for someone to talk to.]  
**3** *n* a dull continuous pain

**ac•tor** \ak-tər\ **n** A person who acts especially in a play or movie  
**ac•tress** \ak-trəs\ *n* A woman or girl who acts especially in a play or movie  
**ac•tu•al** \ak-čə-wəl\ *adj* really existing or happening; not false [The movie is based on *actual* events.]

**ac•ro•bat** \a-krə-bat\ *n* A person skillful at performing stunts like jumping, balancing, tumbling, and swinging from a bar

**ad•dend** \a-dend\ *n* A number that is to be added to another number [4 + 3 = 7, 4 and 3 are *addends*.]
