Yes, I will. I'll be cleaning.

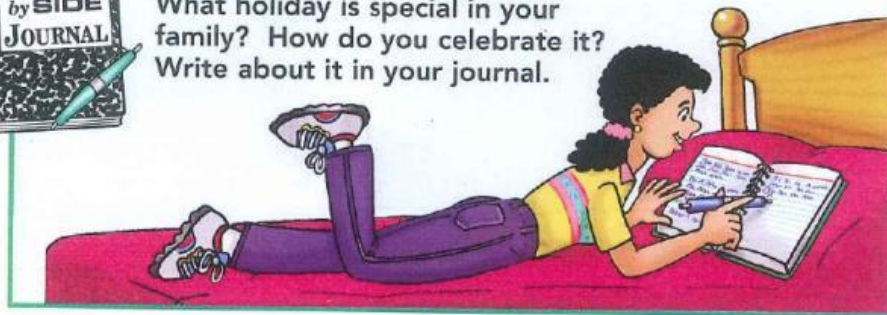
Yes, she will. She'll be studying.
