



# Possessive Nouns



## Singular Nouns

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- The **sun's** rays warmed the earth.



## Singular Nouns ending in S

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- The **bus's** schedule is convenient.



## Names ending in S

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- **Agnes's** cat is playful.
- **James's** car is fast.



## Two or more people

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- Maria and **Carlos's** garden is beautiful.



## Plural Nouns ending in S

- Only add the apostrophe (no S)
- The **students'** achievements were celebrated.



## Plural Nouns NOT ending in S

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- The **women's** team won the championship.



## Classical/Religious Names ending in S

- Only add the apostrophe (no S)
- **Jesus'** teachings are profound.



## No Noun after Apostrophe S

- Add 's (apostrophe S)
- Whose car is this? It's **Sarah's**.
