I think that the president's decision on Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) is the best in the country.

I believe many people will complain about transportation because of another Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ).

I guess there will be another Social Amelioration Program (SAP) because of the MECQ.
