




























Unit 6 - In An Emergency

lie	ξαπλώνω, είμαι ξαπλωμένος Cats likes to lie in the sun.	
across	απέναντι, από τη μια μεριά στην άλλη Let's jump across the river. I can't see a bridge.	
first aid / first aid kit	πρώτες βοήθειες / κουτί πρώτων βοηθειών The first aid kit is behind the bathroom mirror.	
accident	ατύχημα Charlie and Jane had an accident because he wasn't careful.	
fall over	πέφτω, σκοντάφτω Please tidy your room! I fell over your backpack.	
hurt	πονάω, τραυματίζω I fell yesterday and hurt my knee. My knee still hurts today.	
call	τηλεφωνώ, καλώ Jimmy called you yesterday but you didn't answer the phone.	
x-ray	ακτινογραφία The doctor looked at my x-ray and said that my elbow was fine.	
cut	κόψιμο, πληγή Don't worry, it's not a bad cut.	
fix	επισκευάζω, φτιάχνω Grace tried to fix the machine before she threw it out.	
do the dishes / do the washing up	πλένω τα πιάτα My brother and I always do the dishes after dinner.	

cycle	<p>κάνω ποδήλατο, κάνω ποδηλασία</p> <p>Jill and Hugo often cycled when they were children.</p>	
off	<p>(κάτω) από</p> <p>Some books fell off the shelf when I cleaned yesterday.</p>	
ambulance	<p>ασθενοφόρο</p> <p>They took the woman to hospital with an ambulance. Let's hope she's OK.</p>	
medicine	<p>φάρμακο</p> <p>The doctor gave Ben some medicine for his cough.</p>	
useful	<p>χρήσιμος</p> <p>A Swiss knife is a useful tool when you go camping.</p>	
bandage	<p>επίδεσμος</p> <p>Oliver cut his hand so the nurse put a bandage around it.</p>	
bone	<p>κόκκαλο, οστό</p> <p>The Smiths found some dinosaur bones on their farm.</p>	
patient	<p>(adj) υπομονετικός, (noun) ασθενής</p> <p>There were lots of patients in the hospital and the nurses were busy. People had to be patient and wait for their turn.</p>	
caller	<p>αυτός που τηλεφωνεί/καλεί</p> <p>The caller didn't tell the receptionist her name but she left a message.</p>	
age	<p>ηλικία</p> <p>Julia is the same age as Harry.</p>	
while/as	<p>καθώς, ενώ</p> <p>Please don't eat or drink while you're driving. It's dangerous</p>	
stairs	<p>σκάλα, σκαλιά</p> <p>Don't leave your bags on the stairs. Someone will have an accident!</p>	

office	<p>γραφείο (ο χώρος)</p> <p>A lot of people work in an office. They use a computer and they have their own desk.</p>	
ever / never	<p>ποτέ</p> <p>-Have you ever been to Paris?</p> <p>-No, I have never travelled to France.</p>	
have been	<p>έχω πάει</p> <p>Ann has been to hospital three times this year!</p>	
break	<p>σπάω</p> <p>Alex had an accident. He fell off his skateboard and broke his arm.</p>	
ill / sick	<p>άρρωστος</p> <p>Michael didn't travel with us because he was ill.</p>	
weak	<p>αδύναμος</p> <p>Grandma was sick last week and she is still feeling quite weak.</p>	
Be careful!	<p>Πρόσεχε! (Προσέχετε!)</p> <p>The roads are very icy today! Be careful while driving!</p>	
knife (2 knives)	<p>μαχαίρι</p> <p>Daniel cut himself with a knife while making lunch.</p>	
What's the matter?/What's wrong?	<p>Τι συμβαίνει; /Τι τρέχει; / Τι έχεις;</p> <p>-What's the matter with Helen?</p> <p>-She has a headache.</p>	
cry	<p>κλαίω</p> <p>Babies usually cry a lot because they can't talk yet.</p>	
quickly	<p>γρήγορα</p> <p>George run home quickly after his lessons. He was excited to play!</p>	
shine	<p>λάμπω, γυαλίζω</p> <p>It's a lovely day. The sun is shining and it's not too hot.</p>	

through	μέσα από, ανάμεσα The cars have to go through the tunnel, under the bridge.	
be frightened / scared / afraid	φοβάμαι Frank was frightened of big dogs when he was young.	
out of	(έξω) από Alice sometimes falls out of bed.	
carry	κουβαλάω When we go to the supermarket, I always help my parents carry the bags.
