- She forgot to call me yesterday.

= She wishes she hadn't forgotten to call me yesterday.

- We don't live near the beach.

= I wish we lived near the beach.

- He missed the flight this morning.

= If only

- They don't know how to swim.

= They wish

- I didn't bring an umbrella with me.

= I wish

- You don't have enough time to finish the project.

= I wish

- He didn't apologize for his mistake.

= He wishes

- The weather isn't warm enough for a picnic.

= I wish

- I didn't take that job offer last year.

= If only
