We use the Second Conditional to talk about present or future situations we think are impossible or unlikely to happen.

If I were* you,
If clause (Condition)

I'd tell my parents the truth.
Main clause (Result)

We use Simple past in the "if Clause" and "would + verb in the base form"

*Use "were" when using "verb to be" in the if Clause.

If + simple past

If I found wallet in the street

would + verb (base form)

I would try to return it.
